## The NDPR Academy® Foundation Course:

The NDPR Academy® Foundation Course (the **Foundation Course**) is an introductory programme to Privacy Rights in Nigeria and the 2019 Nigeria Data Protection Regulation (**NDPR**). The following Modules and objectives make up the Foundation Course:

Module	Scope + Objective
<b>Module 1:</b> Introduction to Nigeria Privacy Rights Laws	It introduces participants to the basis of Nigeria's current privacy rights laws in a bid to help them appreciate better the current conversations and laws on Personal Data protection.
<b>Module 2:</b> Principles of Personal Data Collection and Administration	It helps participants understand the nature of Personal Data and the 6 globally recognised principles of data protection and processing in light of the provisions of the NDPR in a bid to help them fully appreciate the principles-based and rules-based requirements of data protection compliance and enforcement under the NDPR.
<b>Module 3:</b> The Rights of Data Subjects	It helps participants understand the nature of the 8 rights of Data Subjects under the NDPR and how the rights are protected and enforced under the NDPR.
<b>Module 4:</b> The Obligations of Data Controllers and Administrators	It helps participants understand the concepts of the Data Controller, Data Administrator and related concepts as the Data Protection Officer, Third Party and Data Protection Compliance Organisation as used under the NDPR; setting out their rules and time-sensitive obligations.
<b>Module 5:</b> Local and International Transfers of Personal Data	It helps participants understand the nature and bases for transfers of Personal Data and the separate rules that govern local and international transfers under the NDPR.
<b>Module 6:</b> Data Protection Compliance Processes - Audits and Impact Assessments	It introduces participants to the concepts of Data Protection Audits (DPA) and Data Protection Impact Assessments (DPIA), highlighting the processes involved in each activity. The aim of the module is to help participants appreciate the functions and opportunities of the 2 compliance processes.

<b>Module 7: GDPR Liabilities, Penalties and Remedies</b>	It helps participants understand the concepts (the how and when) of liabilities, penalties and remedies. It uses international examples to explain the lower and upper levels of GDPR penalties. The aim of the module is to help participants appreciate the cost of non-compliance with the GDPR.
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The Foundation Course has been redesigned to be taken both as an online or offline programme, giving potential participants the required flexibility for and accessibility to the programme. It is designed as a 7-hours training for a maximum 25 participants per class. The certification assessment is for an additional 1-hour that may be taken at any-time after the training including on the day of the training. The 7-hours class is designed to be interactive as all course materials would have been sent electronically to registered Participants ahead of the class. GDPR Academy® offline classes are paperless. Participants must accordingly come for the class with their laptops. Internet facilities will be made available for the entire duration of the class and certification assessment. The Foundation Course alumnis will additionally be life-long members of the GDPR Academy®, having access to its vast resources on Personal Data protection in Nigeria.

**The GDPR Academy® Master Course:**

The GDPR Academy® Master Course (the Master Course) is an advanced programme on the GDPR and related laws in Nigeria with a strong bias for global cybersecurity issues. The following Modules and objectives make up the Master Course:

Module	Scope + Objective
<b>Module 1: Principles Of Data Processing: Lawfulness in Focus</b>	This module discusses the principles of Data Processing in relation to the provisions of the Nigeria Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Focus is essentially placed on the principle of Lawfulness as it relates to data processing activities as carried out by a Data Controller on the personal data of Data Subjects
<b>Module 2: Rights of Data Subjects: DSARs in Focus</b>	This module discusses the rights of a Data Subject to his Personal Data as provided for in the Nigeria Data Protection Regulation. It places focus particularly on the Right of Access granted by the GDPR to Data Subjects and aids in understanding of concepts such as the Data Subject Access Request as well as further issues arising in connection to the right of access.

Module	Scope + Objective
<b>Module 3: Principles of Data Processing: Security in Focus</b>	This module discusses the principles of Data Processing as provided by the NDPR and places focus on the principle of Security. It explains in detail the essence of process and system integrity as well as data breach risk mitigation strategies that may be implemented by organisations in the event of the occurrence of a breach incident. It also educates on recommended measures that may be taken by organisations after the occurrence of a data breach incident in order to prevent reoccurrence.
<b>Module 4: The Data Protection Officer</b>	This Module explains the position of a Data Protection Officer (DPO) as provided by the NDPR. It explains instances where the appointment of a DPO is required by the NDPR. It also discusses qualifications, duties and obligations as well as liabilities of a Data protection Officer as provided by the NDPR.
<b>Module 5: Data Protection Audits (DPAs)</b>	This Module focuses the Data Protection Audits as provided by the NDPR. This Module will explain the process in which DPAs are done as well as the types of DPAs, documents and internal procedures of an organization relating to Data Protection. This module will also highlight the contents of a Data Protection Audit Report
<b>Module 6: Data Protection Impact Assessments</b>	The Module focuses on the concept of Data Protection Impact Assessments, the importance of DPIAs in the daily business activities of an organization as it relates to handling of Personal Data as well as in compliance with Data Protection laws in Nigeria.

The Master Course is designed as an offline programme to be held at the Oriental Hotel, Lagos. It is designed as a 12-hours training for a maximum 25 participants per class. The certification assessment is for an additional 1-hour that may be taken at any-time after the training including on the day of the training. The 12-hours class is designed to be interactive as all course materials would have been sent electronically to registered Participants ahead of the class. NDPR Academy® offline classes are paperless. Participants must accordingly come for the class with their laptops. Internet facilities will be made available for the entire duration of the class and certification assessment. The Master Course alumni will additionally be life-long members of the NDPR Academy®, having access to its vast resources on Personal Data protection in Nigeria.

## The Nigeria Data Protection Concave 2020:
